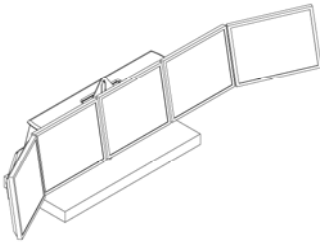


## CASE STUDY: The Tennessee Emergency Management Agency

The State of Tennessee Emergency Management center located in Nashville was created years ago to coordinate all concerned parties when faced with a state emergency situation. When TEMA decided to upgrade their facility, they not only replaced their computer system to take advantage of newer crisis management technologies but also upgraded their main and back-up facilities, including all workstations.

The main center consists of an Operations Control Room and an Emergency Management Room, adjacent to each other. The Operations room is operated 24/7, while the crisis room is used only during emergency situations. Both facilities have a back-up in different locations.

The challenge faced by TEMA was the need to have workstations that would all be based on the same structure, but meet various needs and costs: sit/stand for the main and back-up Operations rooms, fixed and adjustable worksurface consoles for the main Emergency room, and low cost units for the back-up Emergency room. Adaptaspace offered a combination of **GENESIS** and **ADVANTIS**:



The main and back-up operations rooms are equipped respectively with 4 and 2 12' sit/stand consoles, some equipped with the Adaptaspace Power Monitor Arm system and Environment Control (cooled air above the worksurface and radiant heat below).

The main Emergency room is equipped with a combination of 85 fixed and adjustable worksurface consoles (to provide a number of ADA compliant positions) as well as a small sit/stand console configured as a lectern for the emergency coordinator. The back-up Emergency room is equipped with a combination of 25 Genesis and Advantis workstations, to reduce the cost of the facility.
